Calling all students who like to have fun creatively solving problems as part of a team

Odyssey of the Mind® is an international program where students integrate logical problem solving with creative expression. Through completion of brainteasing challenges and development of original presentations, teams of students (4-7 per team) work together to produce scripts, props, and costumes to solve creative problems *competitively* — outside and inside the box!

The amount of teams ECC OOTM will have is dependent upon the number of students & parents that wish to be involved. In order for a team to exist, a volunteer head-coach is required. Without a volunteer coach, a team cannot be formed. You don't have to know anything about OOTM but it does require you to hold meetings/practices

Details:

- Three divisions at ECC: Primary (K-2), Division I (3-5) and Division II (6-8).
- Applicants must submit a written application.
- Students must commit to attending weekly meetings with their coach/team; the frequency (and intensity!) of meetings will likely increase as the competition approaches. Talk to your volunteer coach about their schedule for the season.
- All teams must have a Parent Coach and parents must also be willing to help out at least 5+ hours *per child* as/when needed.

1) Coach _____

- Oversees individual team (The kids work on their project independently. The coach is an overseer and guide for the team, but is not allowed to work ON the project with the kids. Projects are 100% executed by the kids.)
- Attends 1 day online coaches training
- Communicates with ECC OOTM program coordinator (Rachelle Crumrine)
- Commits to leading at least one meeting per week and more as necessary (Timeframe and time dedicated to the program is determined by the coach and the assistant coach. Most often, the home of the coach or assistant coach is used as a meeting place for team projects, practice, and storage. The coach, assistant coach, or another parent will need to store project/problem materials leading up to competition)
- Must attend competition days (Regional - Mid-March, 2024)

2) Assistant coach _____

- Similar to coach, but takes a secondary role as coach (Note: teams may also have co-coaches sharing equal responsibility for the team.)
- Must attend competition days (Regional - Mid-March, 2024)

3) Team parent _____

- In charge of keeping the team needs organized
- Manages team budget, collects funds from parents for team expenses
- Sets up calendar as needed, schedules snack calendar as needed, coordinates team t-shirt order
- Updates coaches and Chairperson with upcoming deadlines - helps spread word about team participation in tournaments to boost team spirit and support

4) Judge _____

(Mandatory for each team to supply a volunteer judge on day of competition)

- Attend regional competition day - donate a day of your time to support this program on the regional level.
- Attend mandatory Judge's training date TBD.

5) Tournament Volunteer _____

(Mandatory for each team to supply a tournament volunteer on day of competition)

- Volunteer time (approximately 2 hours) at regional competition (e.g., check teams in, direct students, help with set-up or cleanup)
